Faculty Members:

Admission Criteria for Bcs. of Nursing

The student should have obtained the General Secondary Certificate or its equivalent for the following streams: (scientific and comprehensive health education), provided that his/her general average shall not be less than 70%. Students who passed the shamel diploma comprehensive exam of community colleges in specializations of (Nursing and Midwifery) are accepted, provided that his/her average shall not be less than 68% where the courses equivalency will be carried out in accordance with the prevailing instruction.

Fields of recruitment:

- Hospitals
- Independent clinics or clinics within institutions (such as universities).

- First aids training & public safety centers.
- Public & private schools (to take preventive measures and deal with emergencies).

Admission Criteria for Master of Nursing Science/Primary Care Nursing

- The applicant must have a bachelor's degree from a recognized university in the major of Nursing or any of the disciplines that can benefit from the program.
- The applicant's general grade for the bachelor's degree be "good" at least and pass the TOEFL test or its equivalent.
- The applicant must have practical experience of at least one year (12 months) in a health institution as well as two letters of recommendation that should be submitted.

Services & Laboratories:

The simulation laboratories equipped with simulatory dummies are part of the practical practice performed, in order to prepare the students in both theory and practice.

The Women's Health Center:

The center was established by a decision of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in 2018 /2019 with the aim of promoting women's health through a holistic framework that takes into account various aspects such as economic, social and psychology, and in cooperation with various bodies with the aim of initiating policies related to women's health that are based on scientific evidence.

1 - Bachelor

(132 credit hours)
